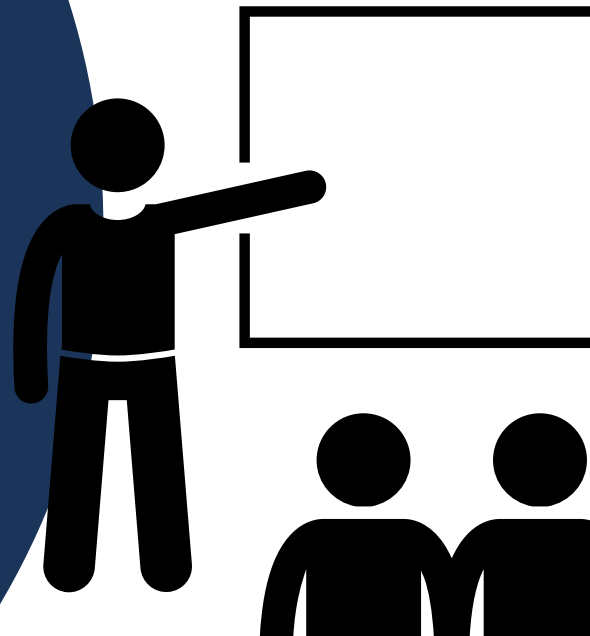

All scientific areas are welcome as long as there is a connection to data generation and/or analysis.
